Can You File Bankruptcy And Keep Your House? - Upsolve

If you have sufficient income to keep up with your mortgage, you will not lose your house. Chapter 13 bankruptcy involves a 3 - 5 year repayment plan. Long-term secured debts, like home mortgages, remain in place. Just like after a Chapter 7 filing, you'll continue to make your regular monthly mortgage payments after filing.

So if you file a Chapter 13 bankruptcy, you are much more likely to keep your house than if you file a Chapter 7. Consider the Equity You Have in Your House. Don't worry, Chapter 7 filers, there are still ways you can keep your house. When deciding whether your house is exempt under Chapter 7, the trustee only considers the equity in your house.

The good news is that bankruptcy can protect your home, holding off a foreclosure. Chapter 13 bankruptcy is designed to allow you to keep your home, even if you are behind on payments. How To Keep Your House In Bankruptcy

How to keep your house in bankruptcy can be a difficult question to answer for everyone at once because the options a homeowner would have depends on their particular circumstances. For example, if you had experienced a temporary hardship that disrupted income and caused you to fall behind on mortgage payments, but have since corrected the problem and have disposable income, you may well qualify for a chapter 13 bankruptcy to catch up the back payments and become current. Alternatively, if your income has declined and not recovered, other options may be a better fit, such as applying for a loan modification in conjunction with your bankruptcy. One underrated aspect of bankruptcy is that it eliminates all unsecured debt typically, which gives a borrower a greater ability to make regular monthly mortgage payments and a greater amount of disposable income because credit cards aren't using up a chunk of income. In this case we'd probably recommend a bankruptcy followed by a loan modification. If the loan modification was not successful, all is not lost. It is likely the lender's review process was not adequate (as it almost never is), and we'd be able to sue your lender for failure to comply with the Homeowners Bill of Rights. This frequently gives us just the right amount of leverage we need to get you that loan modification through litigation and keep your house through both bankruptcy and a lawsuit. As you can see, the subject is complex and each borrowers financial circumstance is different.
