Medicare covers medically necessary part-time or intermittent skilled nursing care, and/or physical therapy, speech-language pathology services, and/or services if you have a continuing need for occupational therapy. A doctor, or certain health care professionals who work with a doctor, must see you face-to-face before a doctor can certify that you need home health services. A doctor must order your care, and a Medicare-certified home health agency must provide it. Home health services may also include medical social services, part-time or intermittent home health aide services, durable medical equipment, and medical supplies for use at home. You must be home-bound, which means either of these is true: 1. You have trouble leaving your home without help (like using a cane, wheelchair, walker, or crutches; special transportation; or help from another person) because of an illness or injury. 2. Leaving your home isn't recommended because of your condition, and you're normally unable to leave your home because it's a major effort. You pay nothing for covered home health services. You pay 20% of the Medicare-approved amount, and the Part B deductible applies, for Medicare-covered medical equipment. Are Home Health Care Services Paid by Medicare

ehealthmedicare.com/ Medicare pays the full-approved cost of all covered home health visits. The home health agency sends bills directly to Medicare. Before your care begins, the home health agency must tell you how much of your bill Medicare will pay. The agency must also tell you if any items or services they give you are not covered by Medicare, and how much you will have to pay for them. This must be explained both by talking with you and in writing. If the home health agency cannot supply medical equipment directly, they will arrange for a home equipment supplier to provide you the items you need.
