On a pre-owned home, the selling brokerage pays the selling brokerage 50% of the commission. On a new home, the builder pays the selling brokerage a commission of the sale. the brokerage then pays their Realtor the agreed upon commission. In this VLOG, Mariko answers the common questions "Do buyer's pay realtor fees" and "How do real estate commissions work?" Essentially, real estate commissions work like a pie. The seller and the listing agent pre-determine a set GROSS commission at the time when they list the property, and that gross commission is then split up between the listing agent and the buyer's agent that brings & assists the purchaser to buy the home. Buyer's SHOULD NOT expect to pay a realtor fee for having a buyer's agent to represent them, and the seller should be paying all of the commission. In addition to explaining how real estate commissions work, this vlog also goes through what it means to be in a client relationship (have a realtor represent you) vs being in an unrepresented situation (not working with a realtor). If you are in a CLIENT relationship (working with a buyer's agent) it means that they owe you: - Loyalty - Duty to fully disclose information (ie sales prices, relevant information about the home, etc) - Duty to avoid conflict of interest (ie cannot represent both the seller & the buyer) - Duty to protect your confidentiality A realtor representing a buyer is there to assist the buyer in finding the home, explaining the process, drafting the contract & suggesting terms/pricing strategy/dates, assessing fair market value and disclosing sales relevant to the subject property, assisting with the subject

removal process, and guiding you through all the way until the completion and possession dates until you get the keys! If you are in an unrepresented relationship (you do not have a realtor working for you) it means that you are in the opposite relationship to a client relationship. Therefore there is NO loyalty, NO duty to fully disclose information, NO duty to avoid conflict of interest as the listing agent is working solely for the seller, and NO duty to protect your confidentiality. The answer on whether you need a realtor is up to you, but it's important that you know what it means to be an unrepresented party and the risks - so that you can make an educated decision on whether you want to hire a realtor to help you with your sale or purchase.
