### Home Health Aide Salary | How Much Money Does a Home Health Aide Make

Home health aides provide routine individualized healthcare such as changing bandages and dressing wounds, and applying topical medications to the elderly, convalescents, or persons with disabilities at the patient's home or in a care facility. Home health aides also monitor or report changes in health status, and sometimes provide personal care such as bathing, dressing, and grooming of patient. There are no formal education requirements for home health aides, but most aides have a high school diploma. Home health aides working in certified home health or hospice agencies must get formal training and pass a standardized test. Their roles and responsibilities depend on the state they work in. Home health aides can provide basic healthcare services to the people they are assisting. This could include checking pulses, taking temperatures, and changing bandages. Personal aides provide nonmedical services such as cooking, cleaning and driving. In 1999, the Bureau of Labor Statistics recorded the average base salary for home health aides at \$18,810. By 2019, the average base salary increased to \$26,440. This is a wage growth of \$7,630 (or \$382 yearly) from 1999-2019. In 2019, the Bureau of Labor Statistics decided to begin surveying home health aides and personal aides together. The estimated 2020 base salary would be \$26,440. Using the yearly wage growth average, we can predict wages over the next 10 years. By 2029, home health and personal aids should have an average salary of around \$30,000. In 2019, average base salaries for home health and personal aids by state range from \$19,680 to \$34,740. There is a \$15,060 difference in wages based on geography. High paying states using 2019 salaries include: Alaska: \$34,740 North Dakota: \$33,330 Vermont: \$32,590 Massachusetts: \$31,500 DC: \$31,150 Washington: \$31,000 Rhode Island: \$29,490 Lowest paying states using 2019 salaries include: Louisiana: \$19,680 Alabama: \$19,960 Mississippi: \$20,860 Texas: \$20,950 West Virginia: \$21,590 North Carolina: \$21,990 Oklahoma: \$22,020 There isn't much difference in pay based on the work environment. There is only a \$1,010 difference between the highest paying work environment and the lowest. Here is how the 2019 pay breaks down by work environment: Intellectual and Disability Facilities: \$25,680 Assisted Living and Retirement Care Facilities: \$25,660 Individual and Family Services: \$25,330 Home Healthcare Services: \$24,670 For this occupation, there are job opportunities in every state. The states with the greatest number of people have the most home health and personal care aides. The states with the greatest number of home health and personal care aides include: California: 595,760 New York: 440,880 Texas: 300,820 Pennsylvania: 183,430 Massachusetts: 108,670 Minnesota: 103,830 Ohio: 94,870 The states with the lowest number of home health and personal care aides include: Wyoming: 3,440 South Dakota: 3,550 North Dakota: 6,140 Montana: 6,710 Delaware: 6,720 Alaska: 6,910 Vermont: 7,230 The government is predicting a 34% growth in home health and personal aide jobs over the next 10 years. This occupation is expected to grow extremely fast. To put this in perspective, the average occupation is predicted to grow by 4% over the next 10 years. Home health and personal aides are expected to grow over 8 times faster than the average occupation. This is a pre-pandemic forecast. Home health and personal aides can't easily socially distance or work remotely. This occupation is affected by the coronavirus pandemic.
