The featured question from today's video is this: If you were starting a semi-professional project studio, how would you allocate the money you have to spend? In order to answer this question, I have to start by asking a question: Are you an instrumentalist? I have been in some professional studios that don't have any gear outside of recording gear, but that may not be the best path for you to take when setting up your studio. The reason I start by asking that question is if you are looking to record local bands and artists from your area, and you want them to sound good, you will want to have a few instruments available for them to use. The reality it, this may be their first experience in the studio, and they may come in with a guitar or bass or drum kit that is barely playable. This is something that has happened to me many times! My last studio had a rental/rehearsal business as well, so I took advantage of that, and this helped me make sure that I could get any piece of equipment of any instrument I may need. When I came to build this studio, I knew I would not have access to that rental business anymore, so I had to think of a solution for that. This is why I have tons of guitars, basses, amps, pianos, and other equipment here. So, if you are planning to record bands, you will probably have to allocate a little bit of your budget to buying some instruments. Overall, you could be looking at roughly \$5,000, or a little bit less, if you are blending used and new equipment. To keep costs down and make things more cost-effective for yourself, don't be afraid to buy used! Just make sure you are paying attention to what you are buying and ask the right questions to make sure you are getting the right value for your money. If you want all new equipment, you could be looking at well over \$5,000. The budget for your studio will really depend on your needs. Will you be recording bands? Will they need equipment? Do you want all new, or are you going to buy some used as well? It all depends on what your needs are and how much you are willing to spend! Rode NT1-A Kit - \$230 or Rode NT1 \$269 [amzn.to/2DQ7AGj](https://www.amazon.com/dp/B00002DQ7AGj) This is an incredible microphone I trust anything with the Rode name on it. They are a very trusted brand in audio gear. This lav I am using is actually a Rode microphone and transmitter and receiver. I paid \$400 for this and it works amazing. The Rode NT1-A Kit which I'll put a link to below comes with a pop filter as well so you won't have to buy one separately. The NT1A gives you a little bump at the low end to round things out a little, but then hits you hard with plenty of hump in the presence and air regions to bring things to the front of the mix without having to reach for an eq. The new NT1 on the other hand, keeps things nice and flat. Really I'd say if you are super new to mixing you just get the NT1-A so you feel a psychological boost when hearing your unmixed recordings. Blue Microphones Bluebird \$300 This is a very popular microphone with a very clean sound and a really unique look. You have probably seen these before. A Preamp is what amplifies the signal of a microphone and it is plugged BEFORE the microphone hence the name PRE AMP My favorite thing to recommend for up and coming people on a budget is the \$100 Focusrite Scarlett Solo (2nd Gen) USB Audio Interface with Pro Tools [amzn.to/2DOKW0T](https://www.amazon.com/dp/B00002DOKW0T) It's only \$100, has a great quality sound and comes with Pro Tools which would cost you \$100 anyways. It's how I put up all of the stuff in this room as you can see. And the same acoustic treatment I am recommending is what I have up on the wall here. The list of everything I mentioned in this video is below for you along with links directly to the items But here is a round up for you Now This prices do not include you having your computer but to be honest even super cheap \$200-300 laptops or desktop computers have more than enough computing power to run pro tools and allow you to record yourself from home no problem. It also doesn't include studio monitors which are the speakers to mix your own music. But you don't need that stuff yet. At this level you can do basic mixes through decent head phones or you can pay someone who knows what they are doing to mix and master your songs for cheap. 

Are recording beats to sell? Are you trying to figure out how to build a studio so you can record an entire band? The main two things you'll need in your music studio setup are a computer and a DAW, or Digital Audio Workstation. Once you have these studio essentials, you technically have enough to make beats. If you're planning on building a serious home studio setup, you'll need an audio interface. These can get pretty pricey, but there are plenty of affordable interfaces that will get you professional sounding results with your home music studio. Once you have an interface, the next thing you'll need in your homestudio is a microphone. If you're wondering how to put together a home studio, its as simple as plugging your audio interface into your computer, and then plugging your microphone into your audio interface. You can do this with an XLR microphone cable. I quickly show you how to put together a home studio in this video. Really, the only other thing you'll need is a pair of headphones and studio monitors. Once you plug your studio monitors into the back of your audio interface, you know how to setup a home studio. Lots of people want to know how to build a home studio for under \$350, and it's completely doable if you already have a computer. There are plenty of free DAW's out there, and you can get an audio interface and microphone bundle for pretty cheap. Be sure to look at product reviews when you're trying to figure out exactly what to buy for a home studio. By the end of this video, you'll know how to make a home studio. Is It Worth It to CREATE Your Own FILM STUDIO or Should You Rent (How to Build a Studio)

Often here at Film Jams we are asked if it is worth it to create your own film or photo studio. Should you get your own, rent from someone else's, or shoot in your house? How about all the gear you have to buy along with it and other extraneous costs? And how to build a studio? Watch the video to find out more! It is important to consider location when thinking about how to create a film studio. Do you live in a huge city like New York City, a mid-sized city like us in St. Petersburg, Florida, or a small town? Our team considered what our area already had to offer before we began. It was either large, expensive studios, or tiny studios that had older gear and lackluster locations, like next to the train tracks. We decided to open our studio as a mid-sized option to fill that gap for video and photo studio rental in our area. What about home studios? Can you create a video studio in your house? If you have some spare space or an extra room, it might make sense to utilize it for certain projects. Creating your own DIY film studio should be a space that works for what you need to do. Customize it for your video production or photography studio needs. It's also important to consider how many clients per month you'd need to meet basic rent for the studio or soundstage on top of your other expenses. Is it realistic to break even? How big are your video studio projects? Do you need the space and professionalism of your own studio or are you small enough that a small setup in your house will work? And ultimately, should you create your own film studio? These are just some of the questions we address in our video this week. So photo studio rental or buy?
